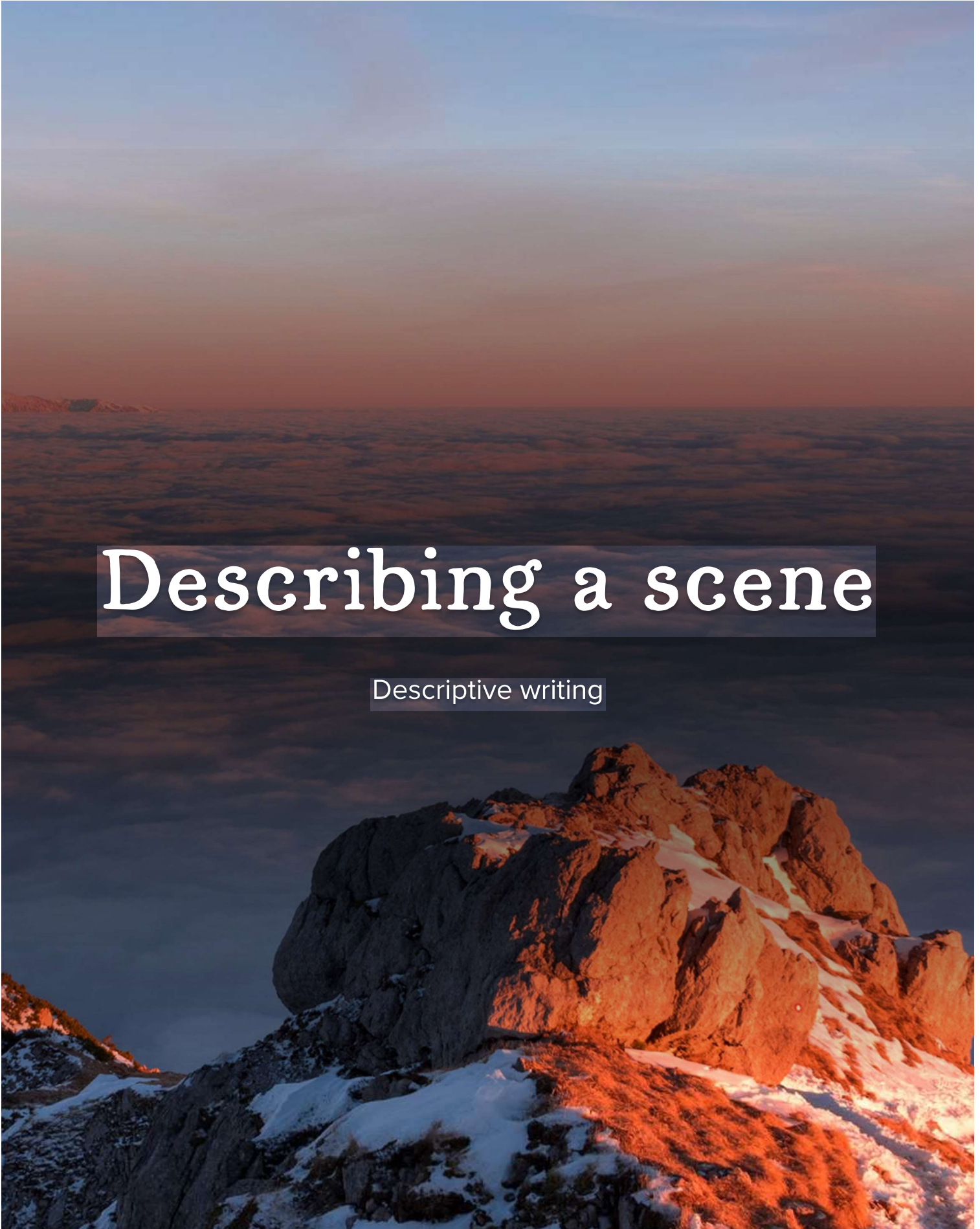

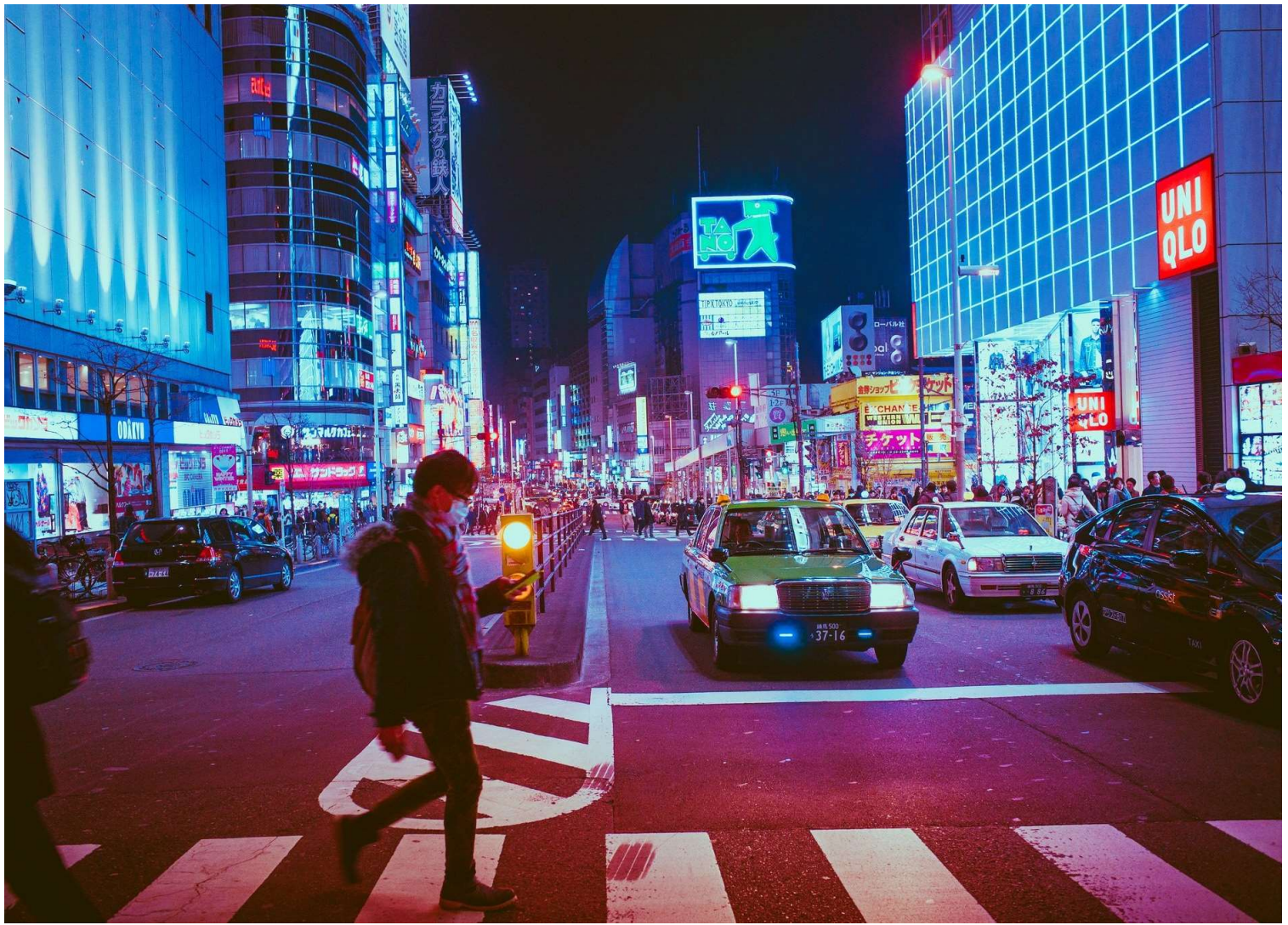




What is a scene?

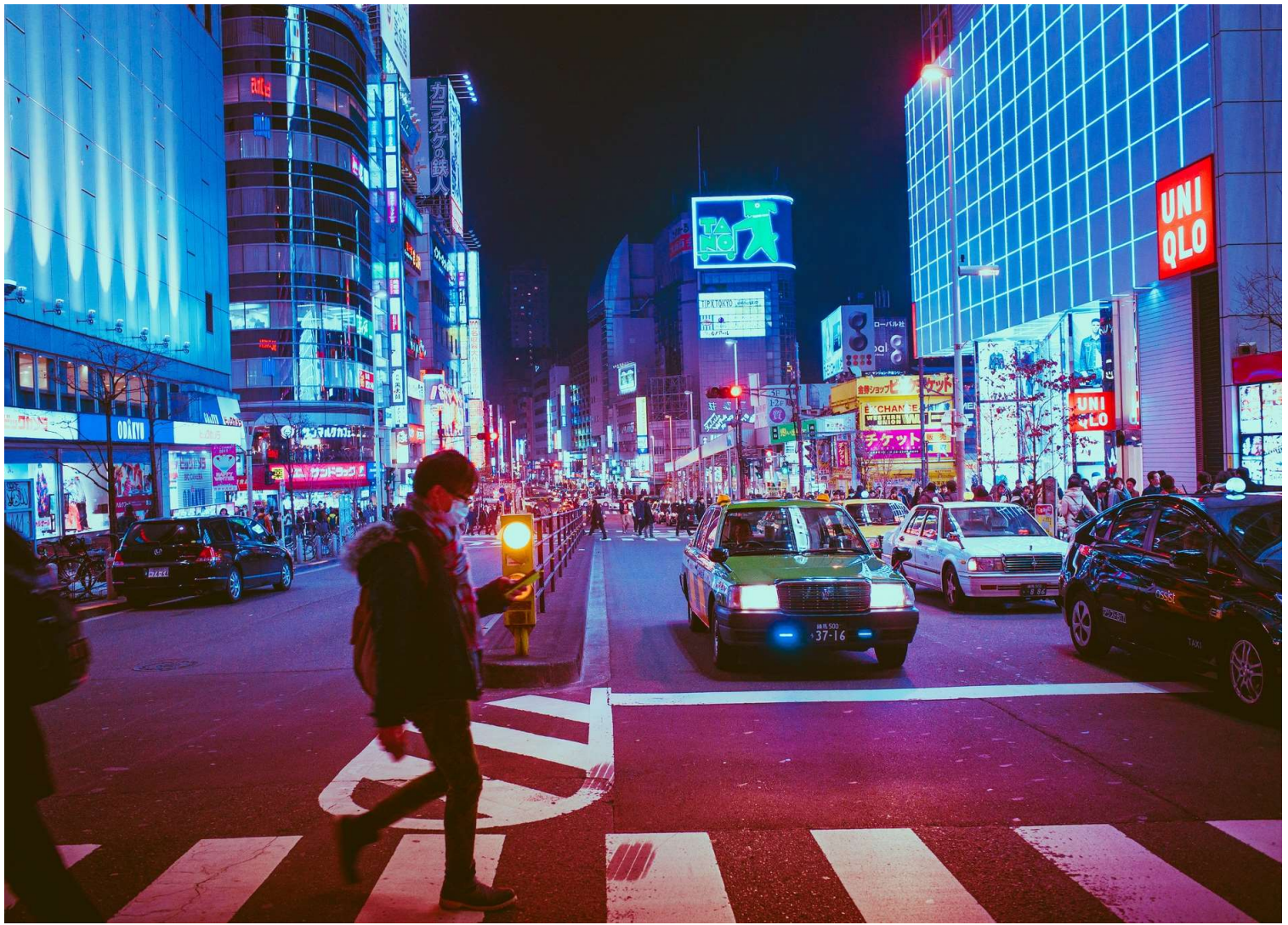
A scene is a place where something happens.

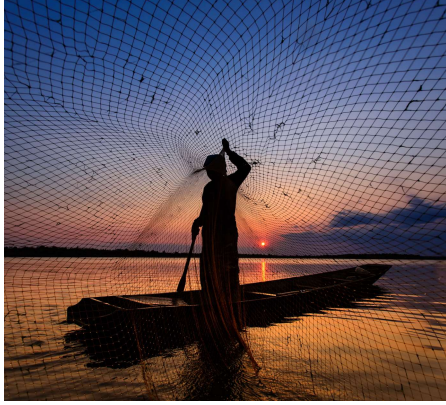

Choose an image and write a description of the scene.



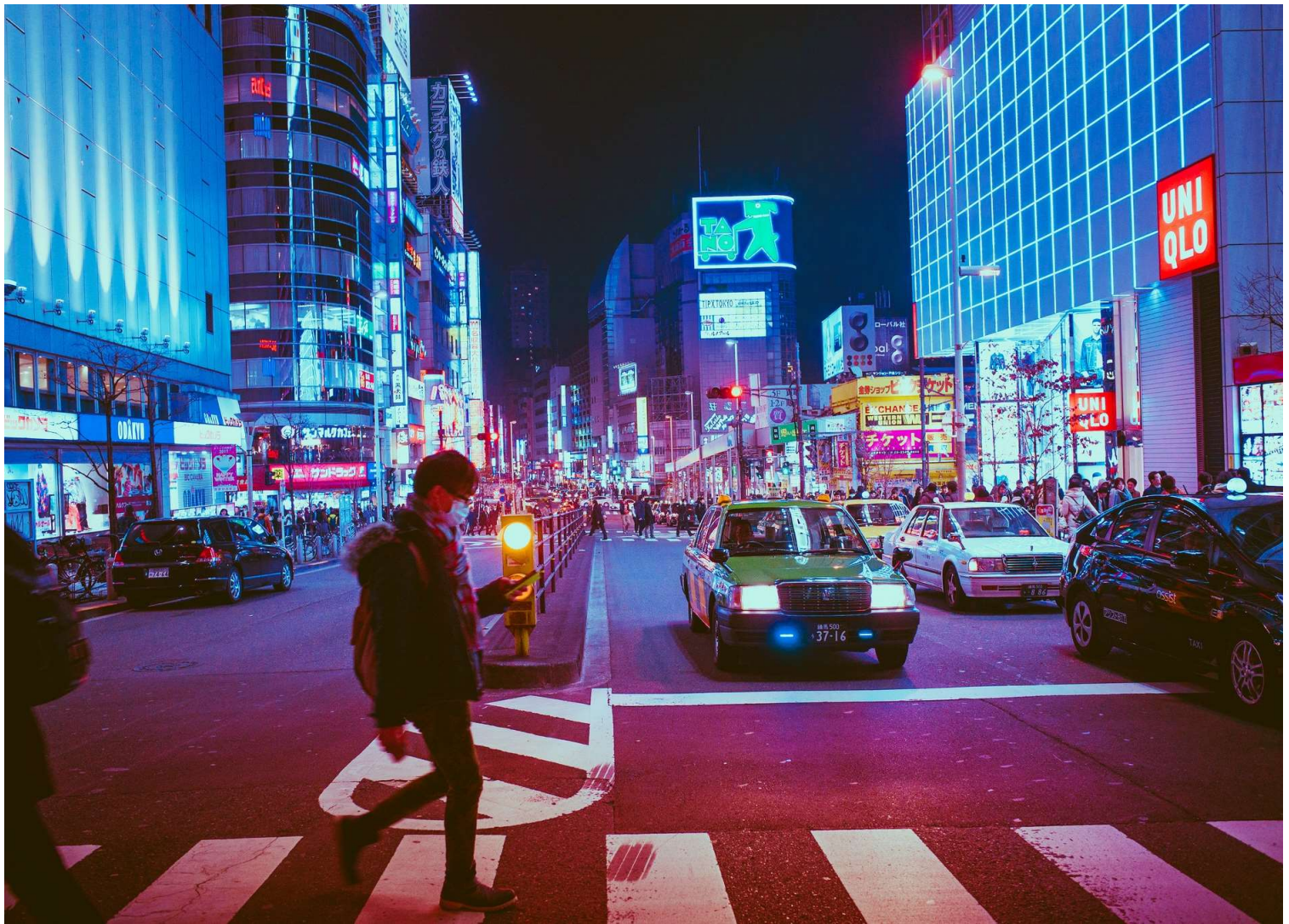
Answers:
