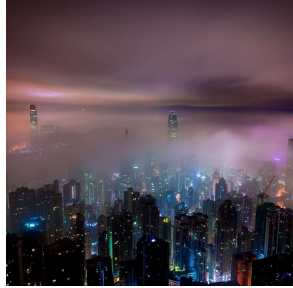
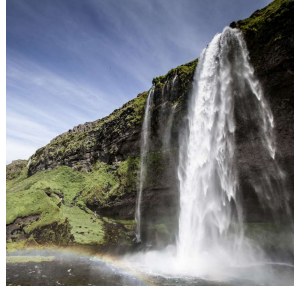
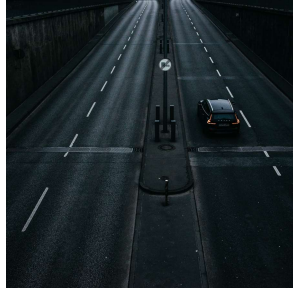
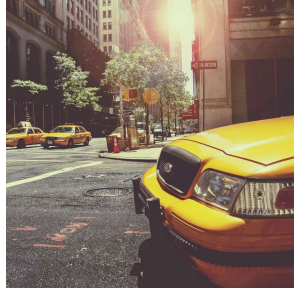
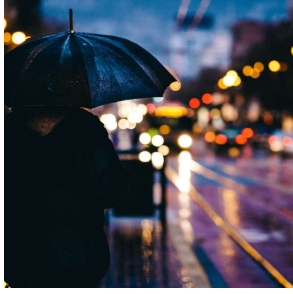


# Specific Vocabulary

# Vocabulary

gazed up (verb) = looked with love or amazement

awe (noun) = wonder

hiked (verb) = walked with effort

rough terrain (adjective + noun) = not smooth ground

trekking (verb) = long, difficult journey on foot

exhaustion (noun) = strong tiredness

vision of wonder (noun) = amazing sight



stared listlessly (verb + adverb) = look at something for a long time in a bored way.

draped (verb) = to hang loosely

slouchy (adjective) = relaxed/ not smart

ostentatious (adjective) = showy

broadcast (verb) = to share information widely
